Lesson	WOW, School
Grade:	Grades K Elementary
Subject:	School readiness; positive attitude toward school


Topic:	Students will identify things they like about school
Standards:	•
Materials:	 Book: WOW! School!, by Robert Neubecker WOW! School! Workheet
Introduction:	 If first lesson, have students practice introduction ("Hi, I'm Sarah." "Hello Sarah, it's nice to meet you.") How many days have you been in school? Let's count them (refer to calendar). Wow, let's see if our school looks like the school in our story.
Development:	 Read WOW! School! Pause at each illustration and ask if there are similar things in our school. After each passage, ask what they like about art, music, books, etc.

Practice:	 Pass out worksheet. Lead students through worksheet as a group. As the teacher says each section, instruct students to circle the activities they enjoy. Have students count number circled items; if they've circled 5 or more things, have them circle the smiley face about how they feel about school.
Closing:	Review all the things that happen during a day at school WOW, that's a lot! Do we have to like everything that happens at school to like school? No, just liking most of them, makes school a pretty fun place.
