

Lesson	WOW, School
Grade:	Grades K Elementary
Subject:	School readiness; positive attitude toward school

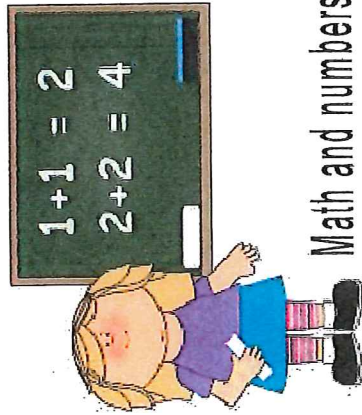
Topic:	Students will identify things they like about school
Standards:	•
Materials:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Book: <i>WOW! School!</i>, by Robert Neubecker • WOW! School! Workheet
Introduction:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If first lesson, have students practice introduction (“Hi, I’m Sarah.” “Hello Sarah, it’s nice to meet you.”) • How many days have you been in school? Let’s count them (refer to calendar). Wow, let’s see if our school looks like the school in our story.
Development:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read <i>WOW! School!</i> Pause at each illustration and ask if there are similar things in our school. 2. After each passage, ask what they like about art, music, books, etc.

Practice:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pass out worksheet. Lead students through worksheet as a group. 2. As the teacher says each section, instruct students to circle the activities they enjoy. 3. Have students count number circled items; if they’ve circled 5 or more things, have them circle the smiley face about how they feel about school.
Closing:	Review all the things that happen during a day at school... WOW, that’s a lot! Do we have to like everything that happens at school to like school? No, just liking most of them, makes school a pretty fun place.
